



FOOD PRICES AND POVERTY

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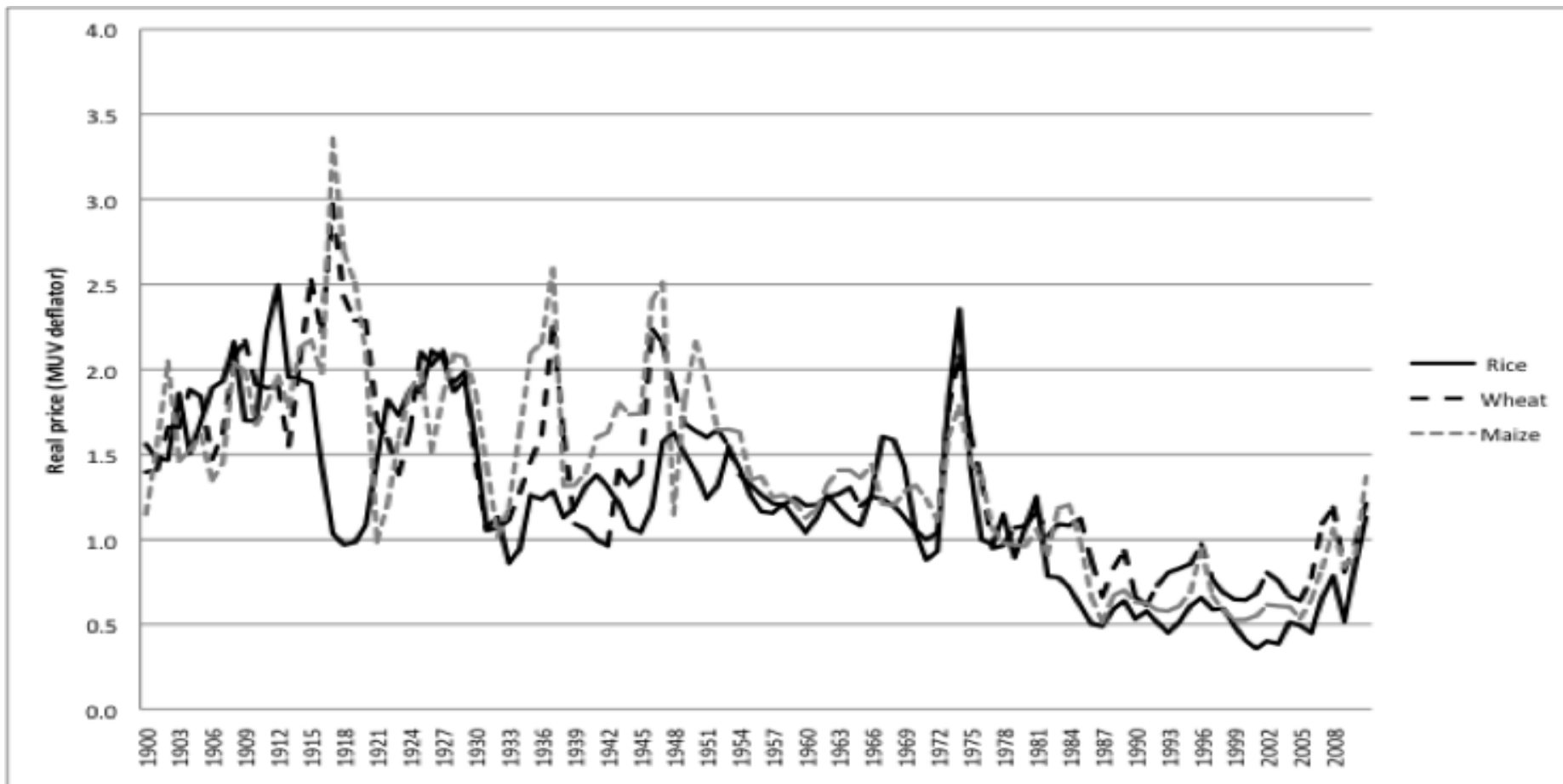
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Food security is back on the international agenda because of recent increases in international food prices.

Following the 2008-08 food price increases, the World Bank said that the high food prices were a serious threat to continued poverty reduction because they harm poor consumers.

But previously, FAO and Oxfam had been saying that low food prices were a concern because they harm poor farmers.

Like any price change, food price increases produce both gainers and losers. The effect on poverty depends on the balance of these opposing effects.

- Net sellers of food gain
- Net buyers of food lose
- Others may be affected indirectly

What is the net effect on the poor?

Three ways of studying the food price / poverty relationship:

- Econometrics
- Economic modeling
- Survey data on net sales of food at the household level

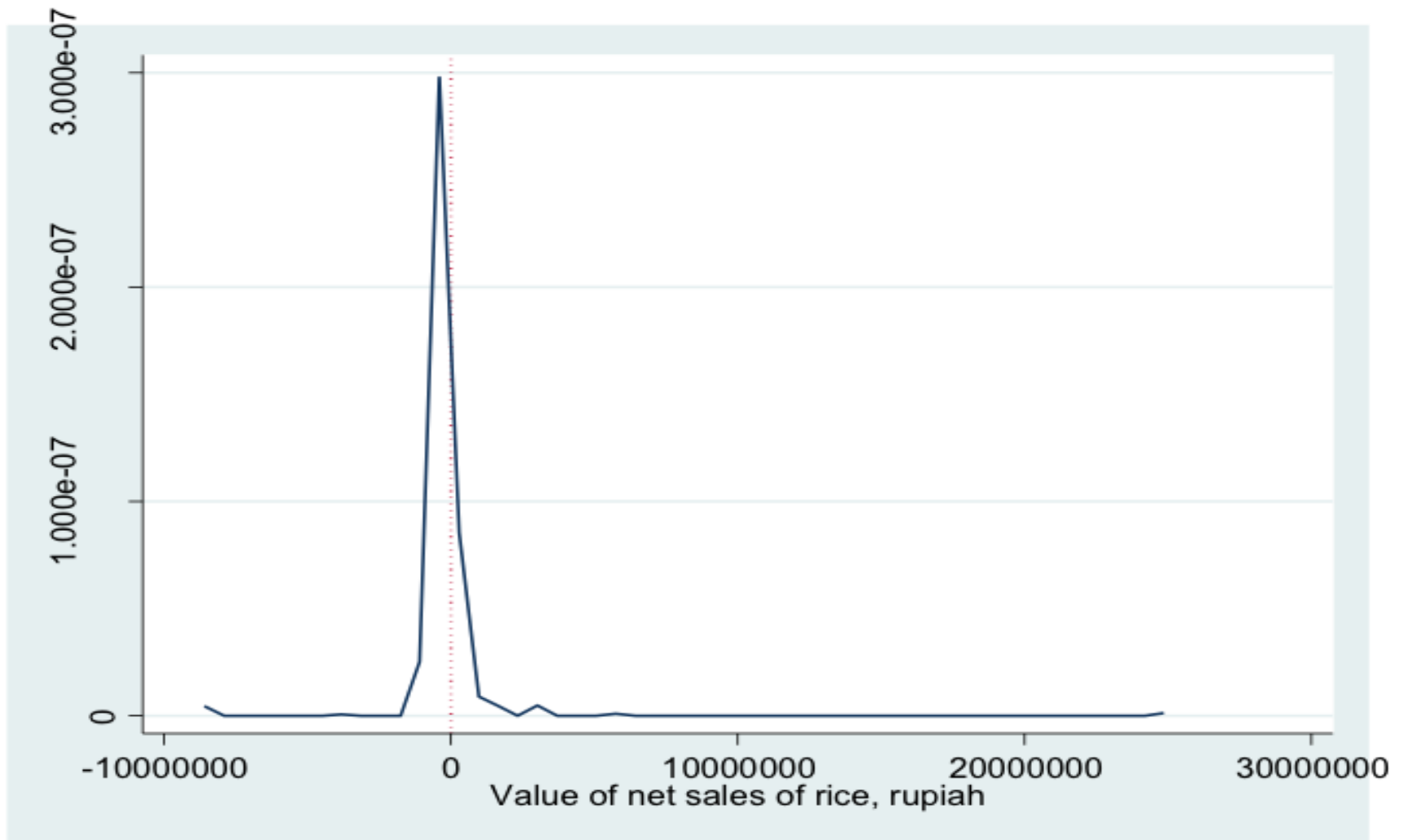

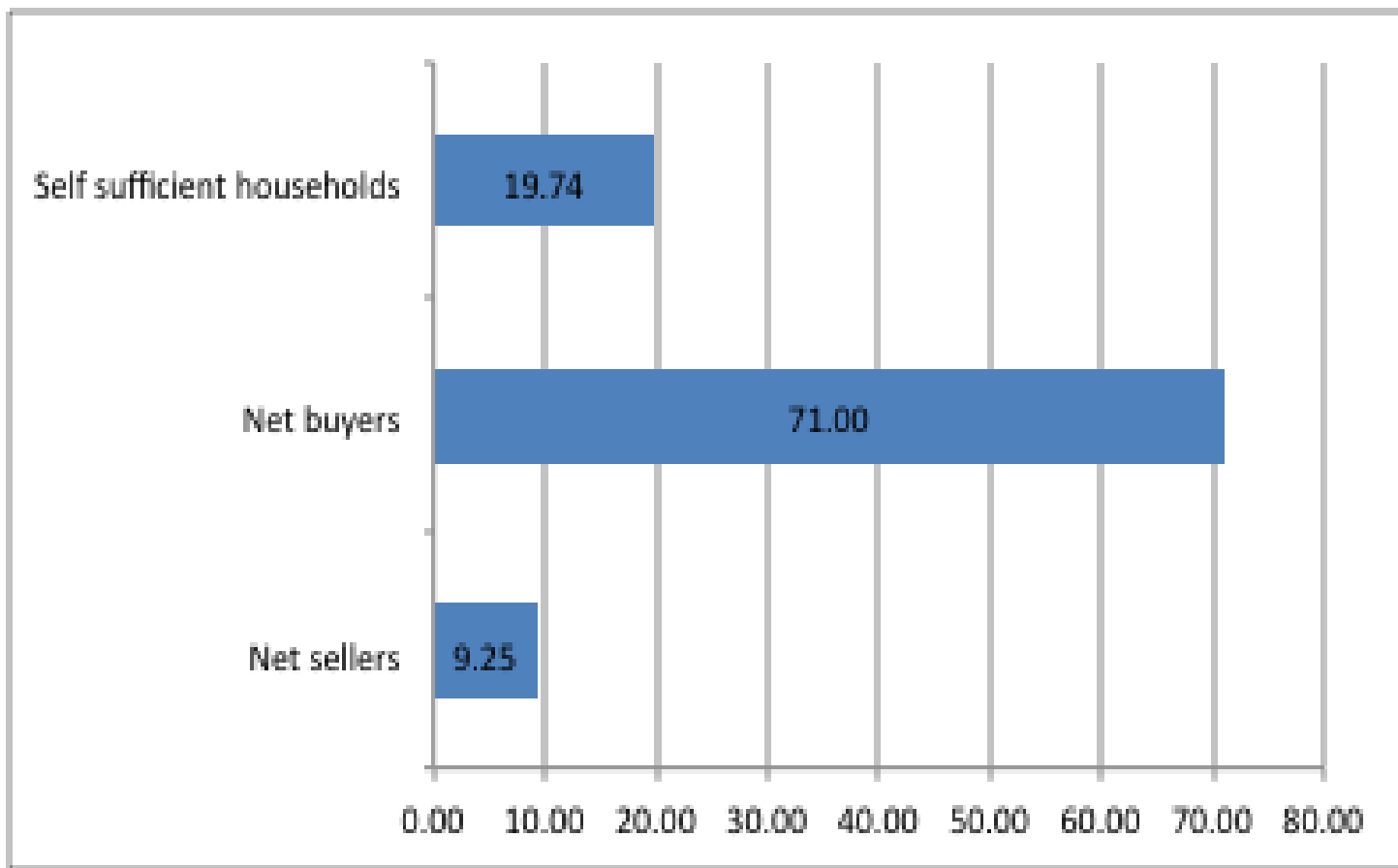

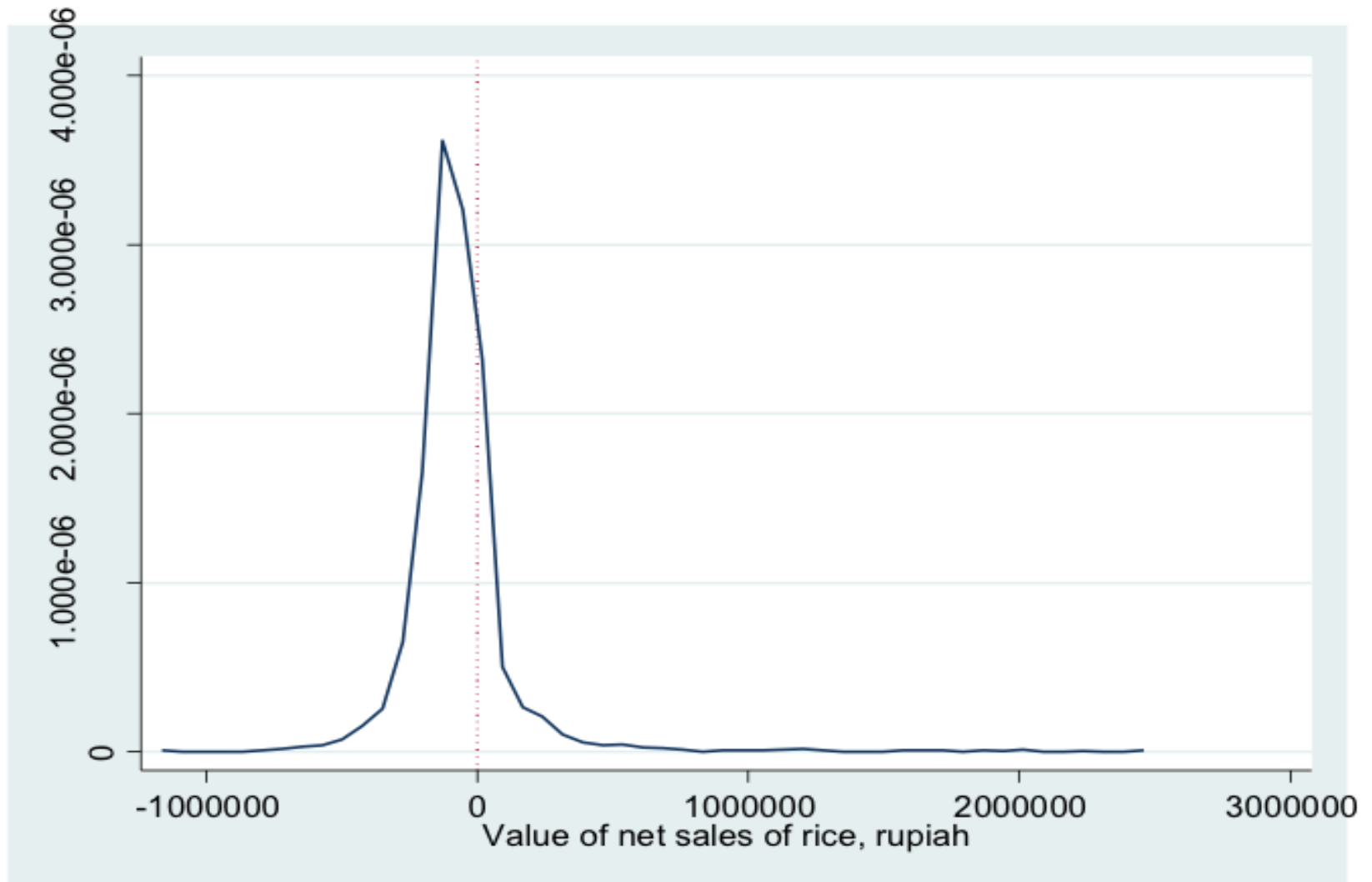
Indonesia: All households, net sales of rice, 2007



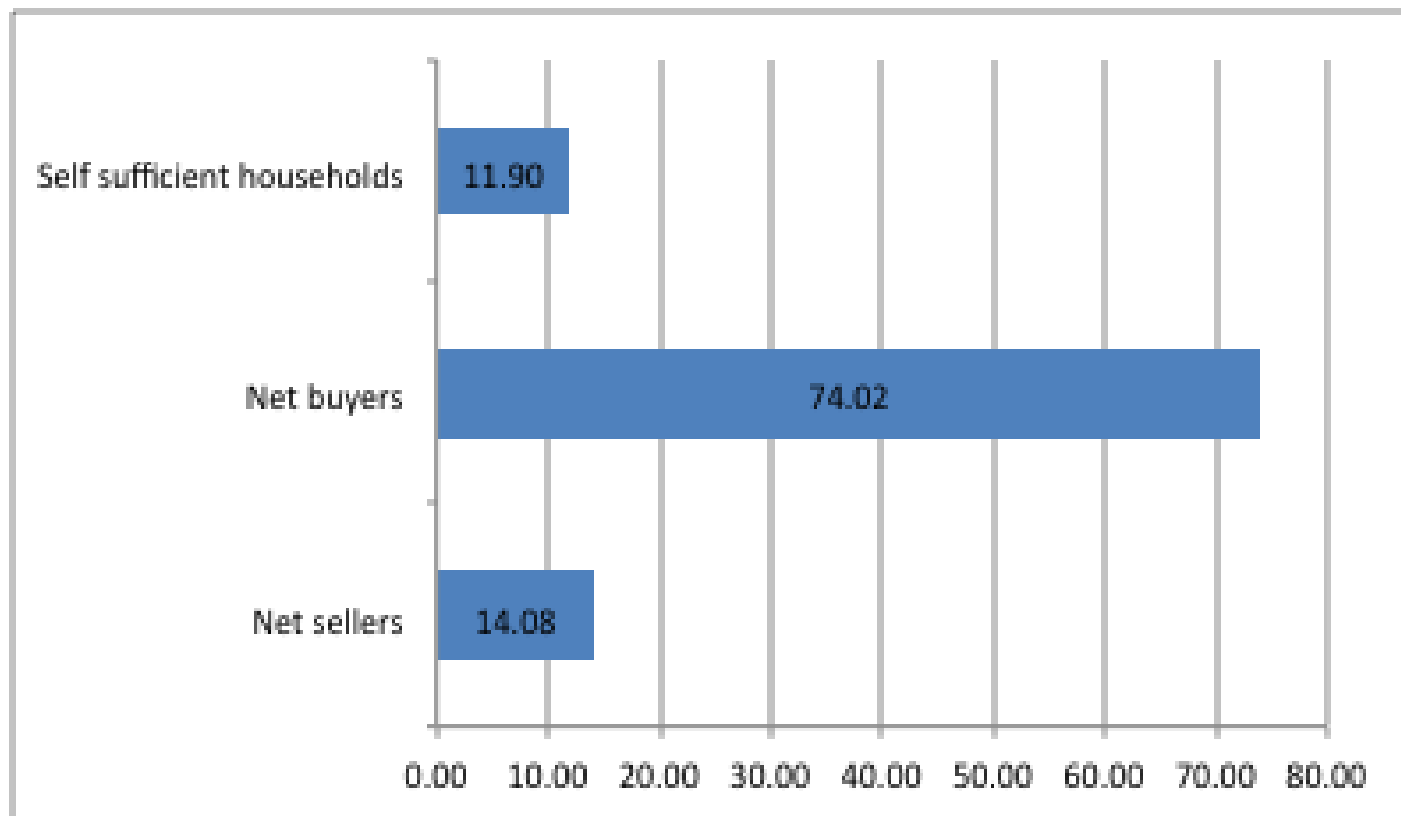
Indonesia: All households, net sales of rice, 2007



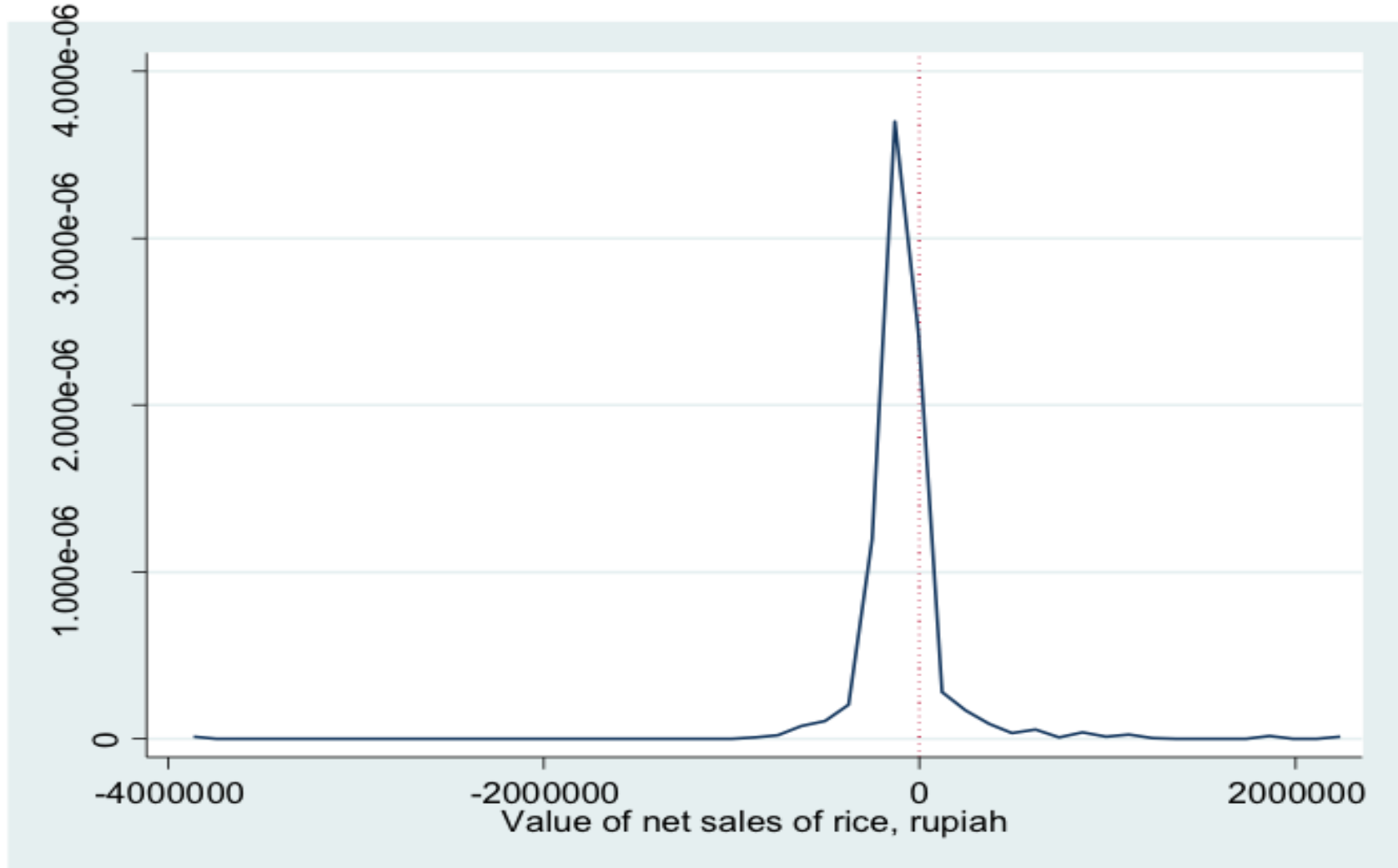
Indonesia: All poor households, net sales of rice, 2007



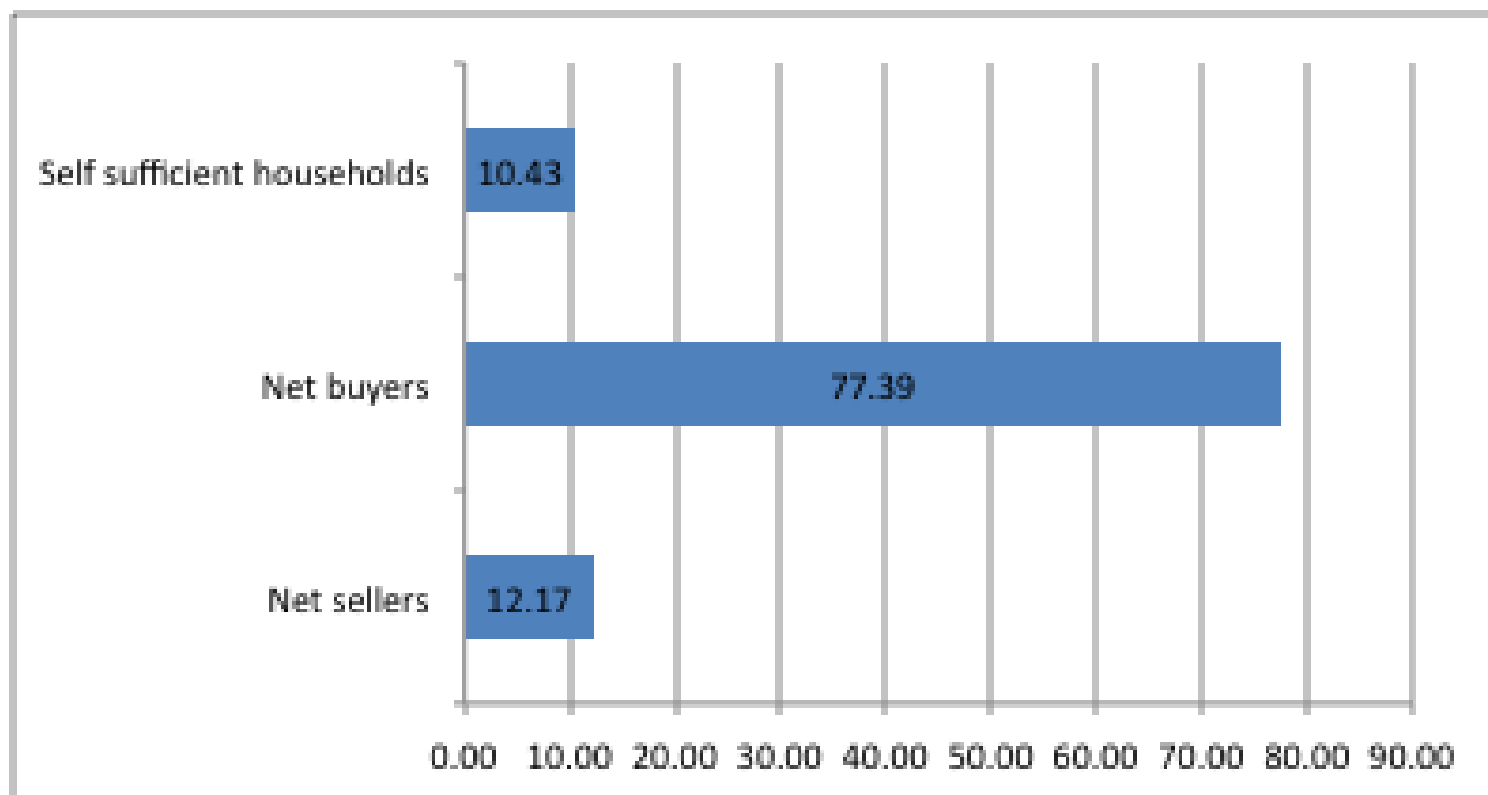
Indonesia: All poor households, net sales of rice, 2007



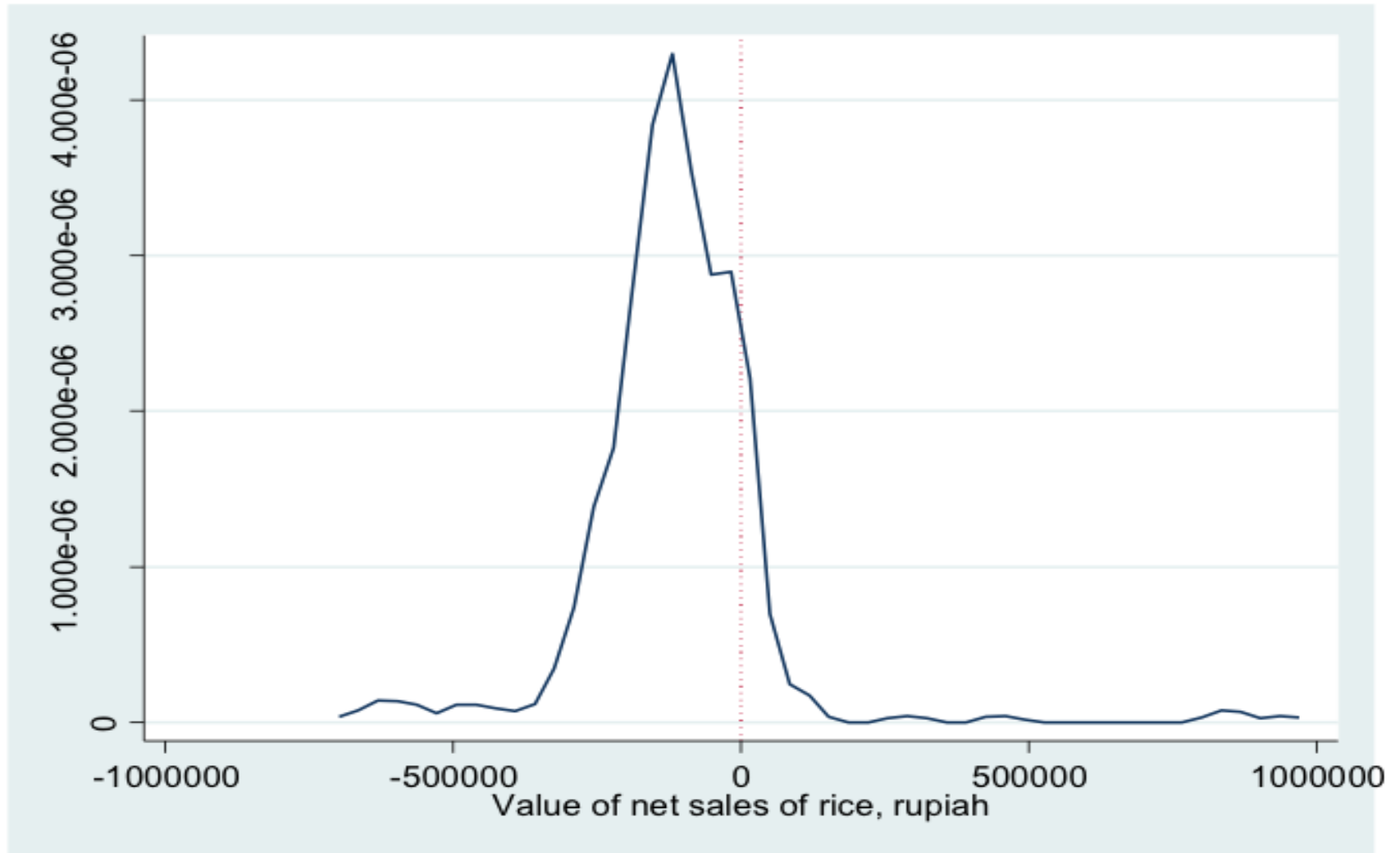
Indonesia: All households close to the poverty line, net sales of rice, 2007



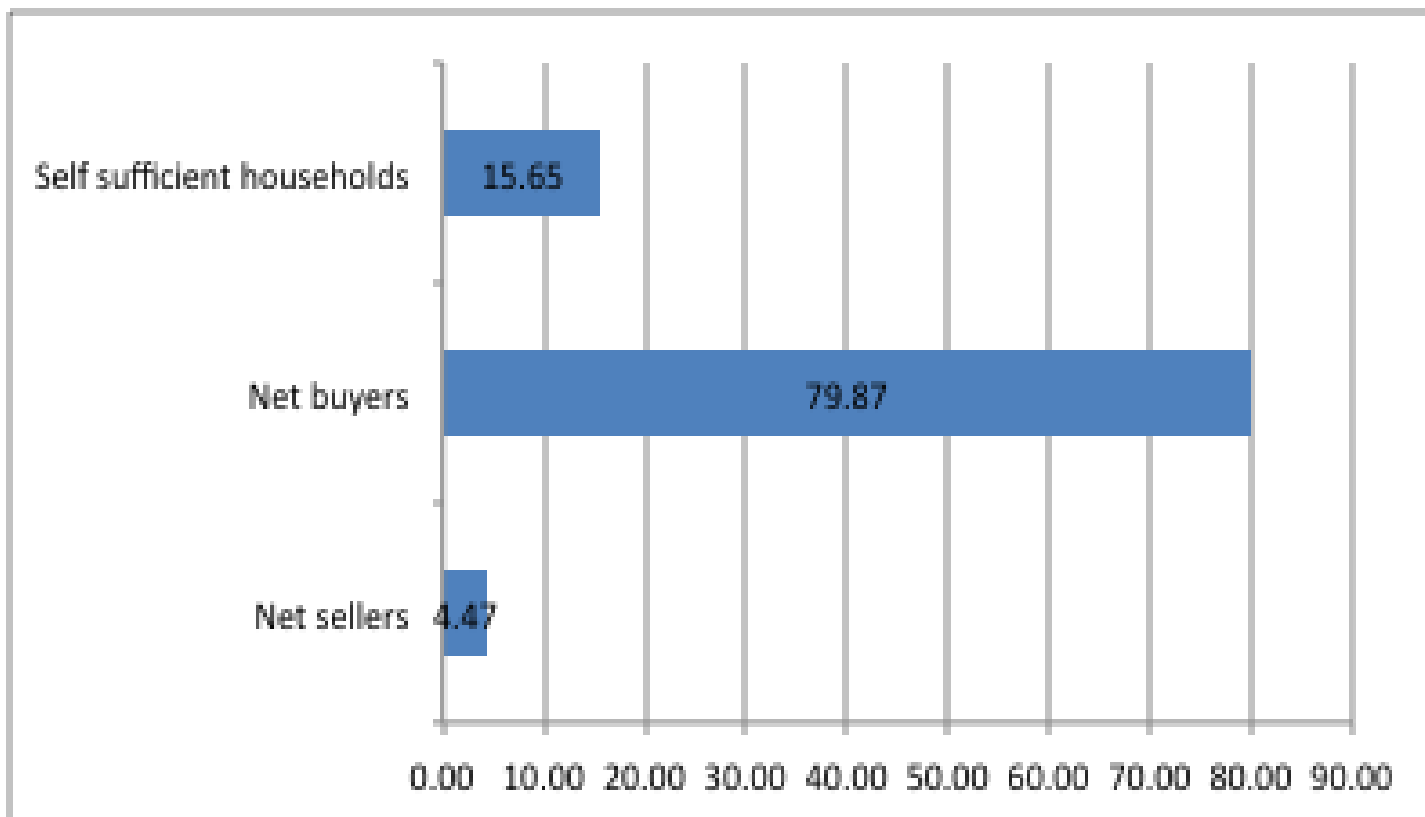
Indonesia: All households close to the poverty line, net sales of rice, 2007



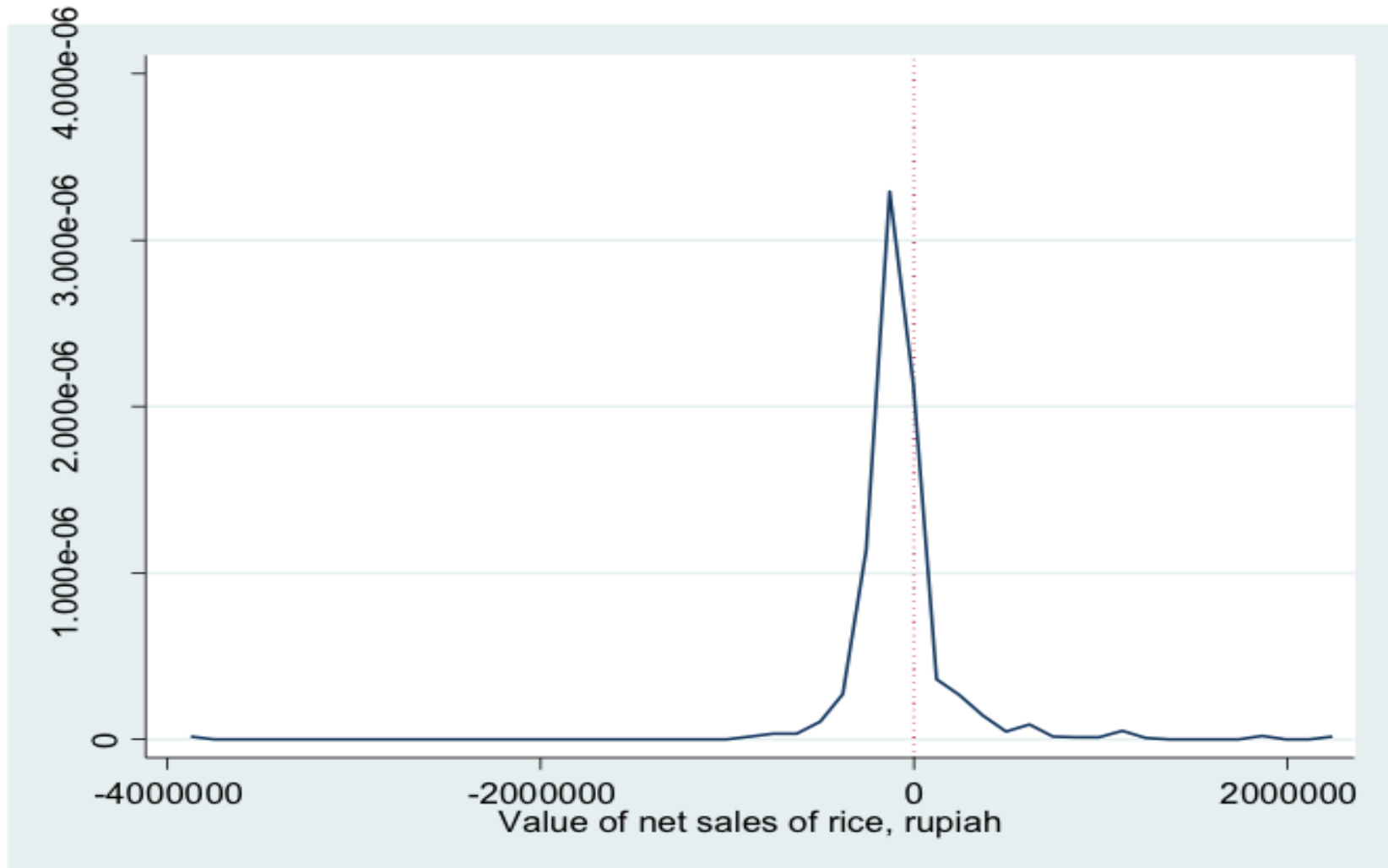
Indonesia: Urban households close to the poverty line, net sales of rice, 2007



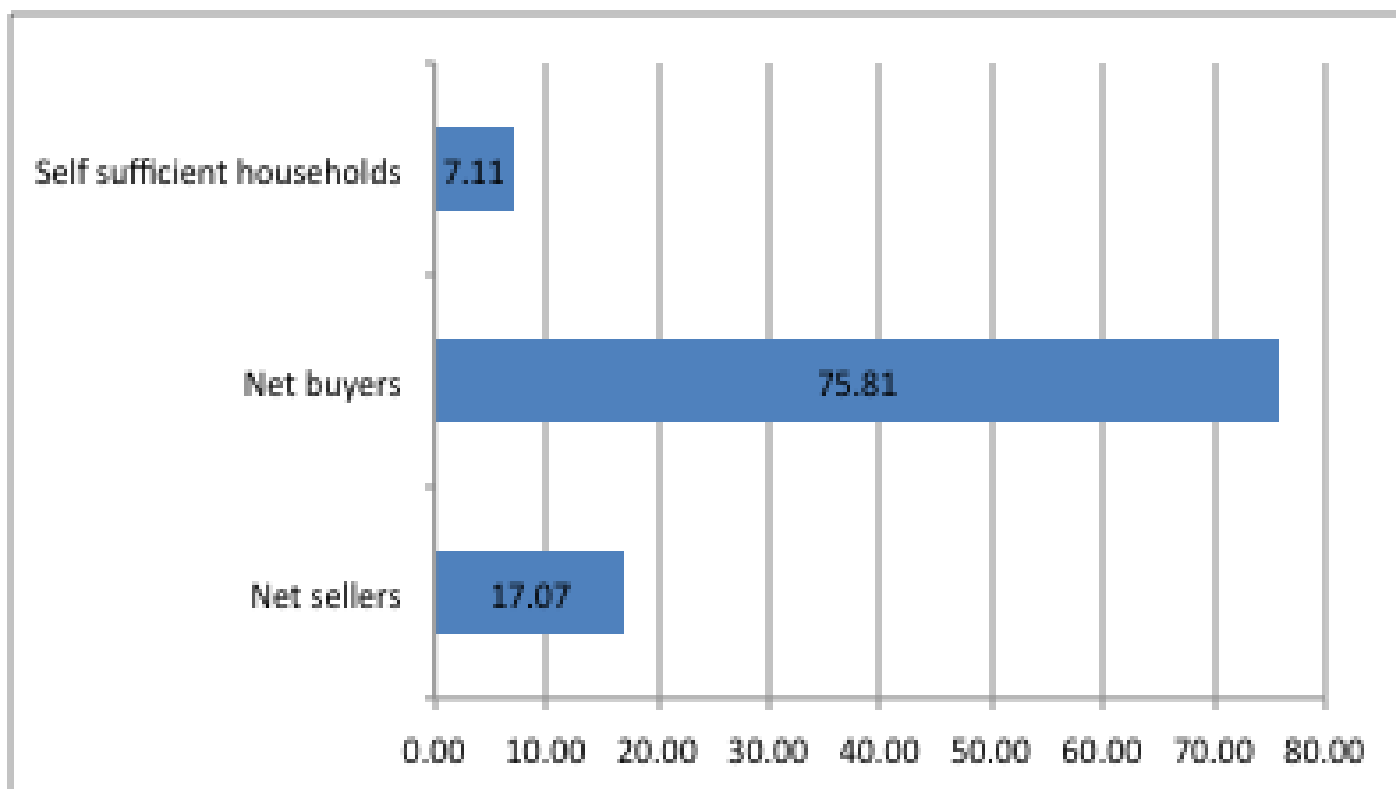
Indonesia: Urban households close to the poverty line, net sales of rice, 2007

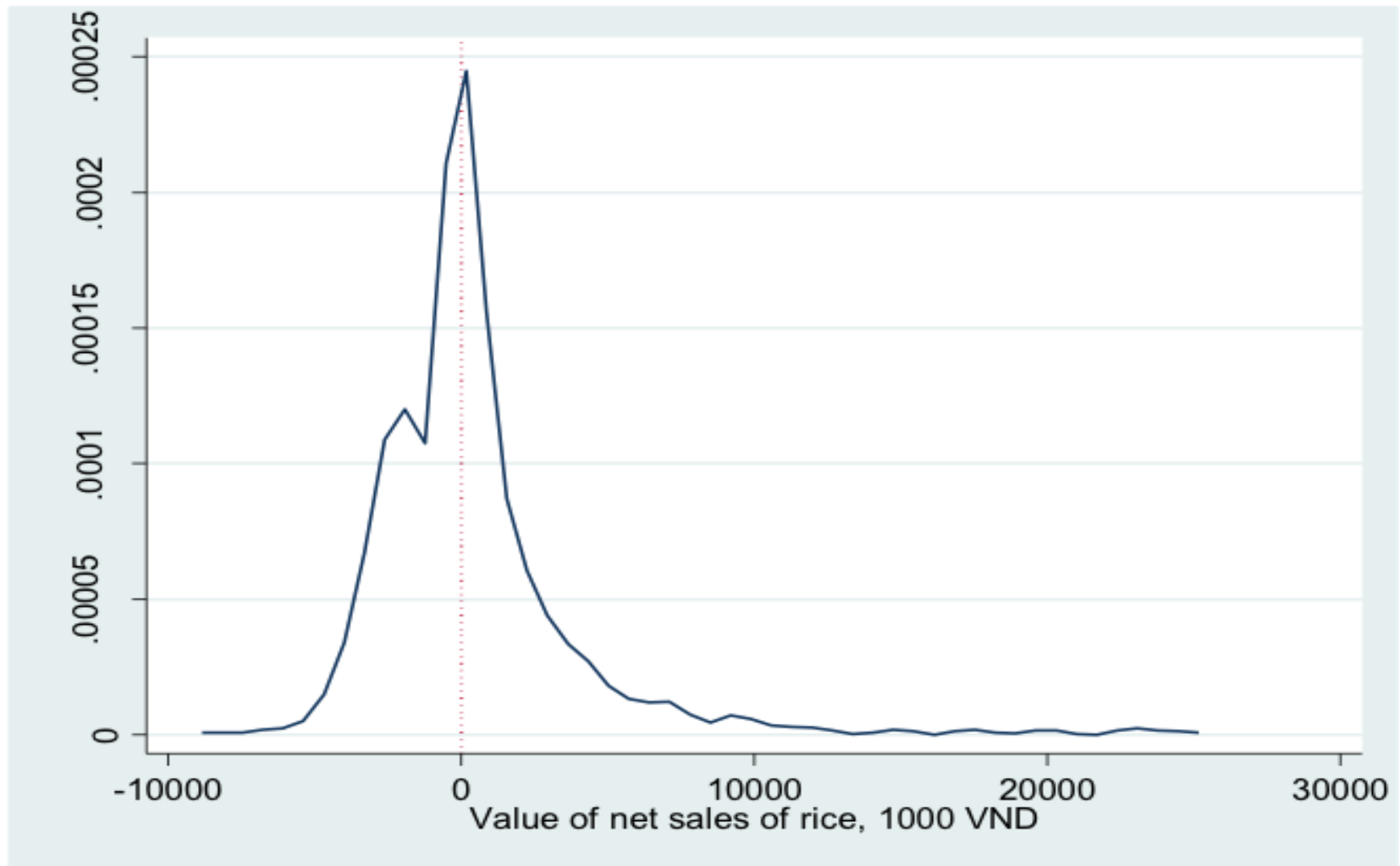

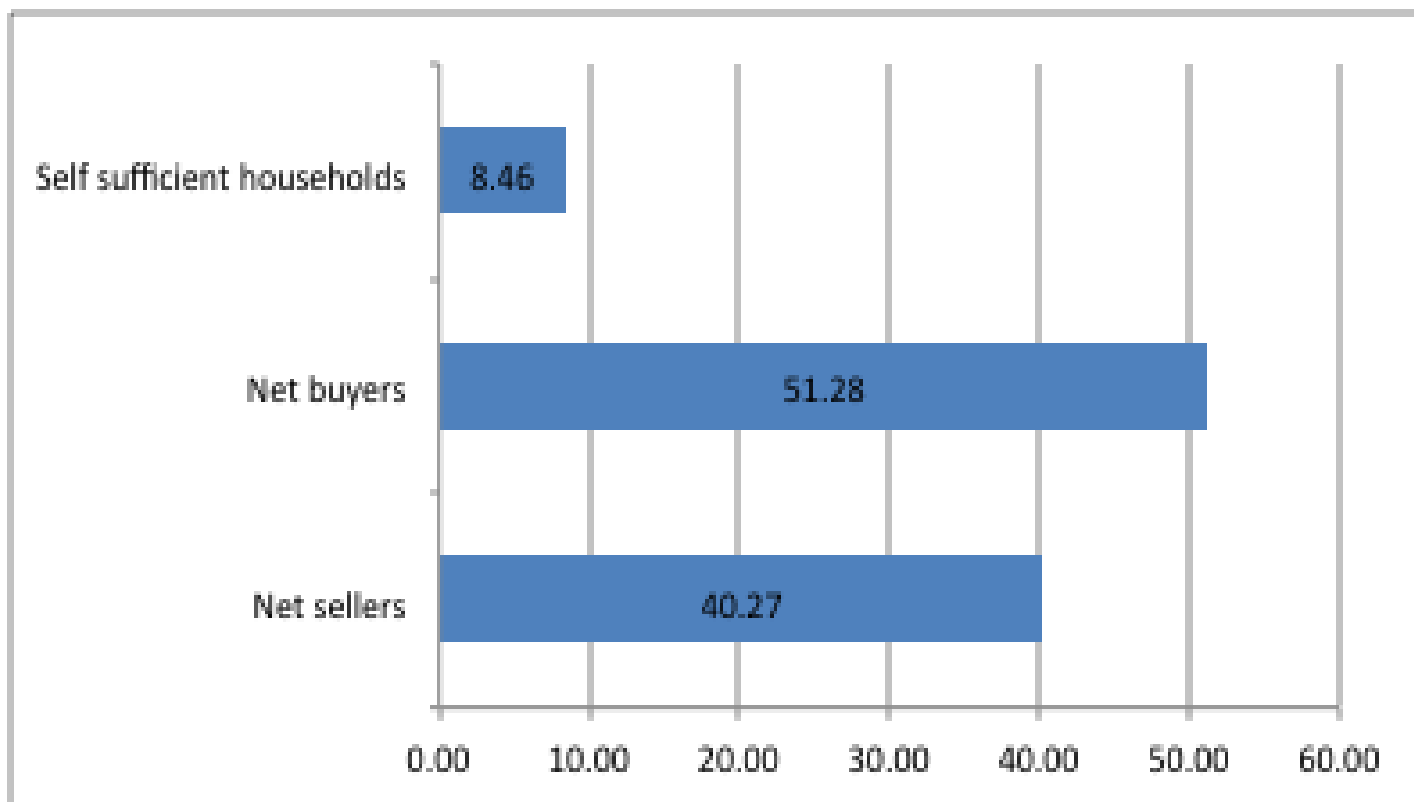

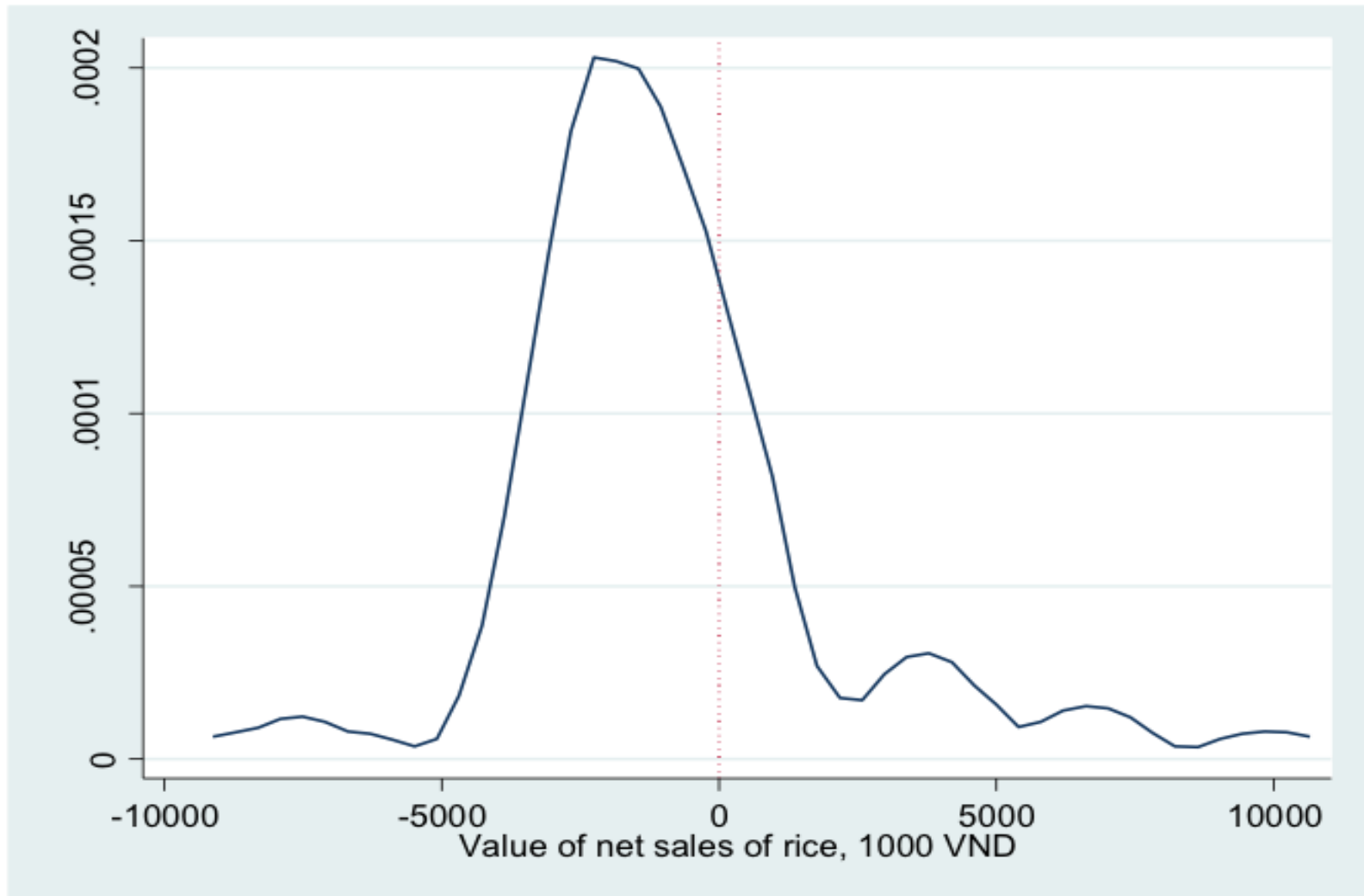
Vietnam: All households close to the poverty line, net sales of rice, 2006



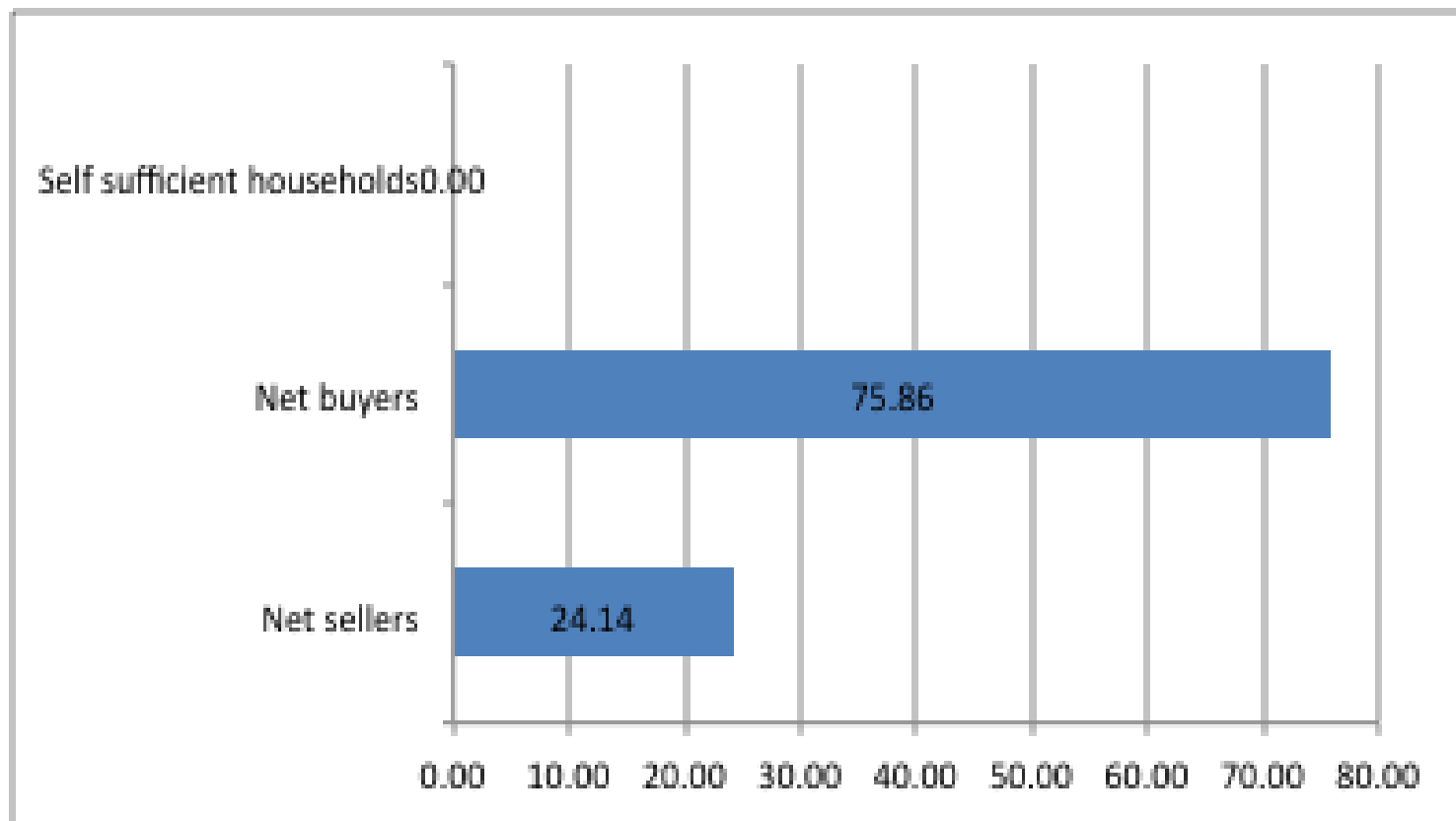
Vietnam: All households close to the poverty line, net sales of rice, 2006



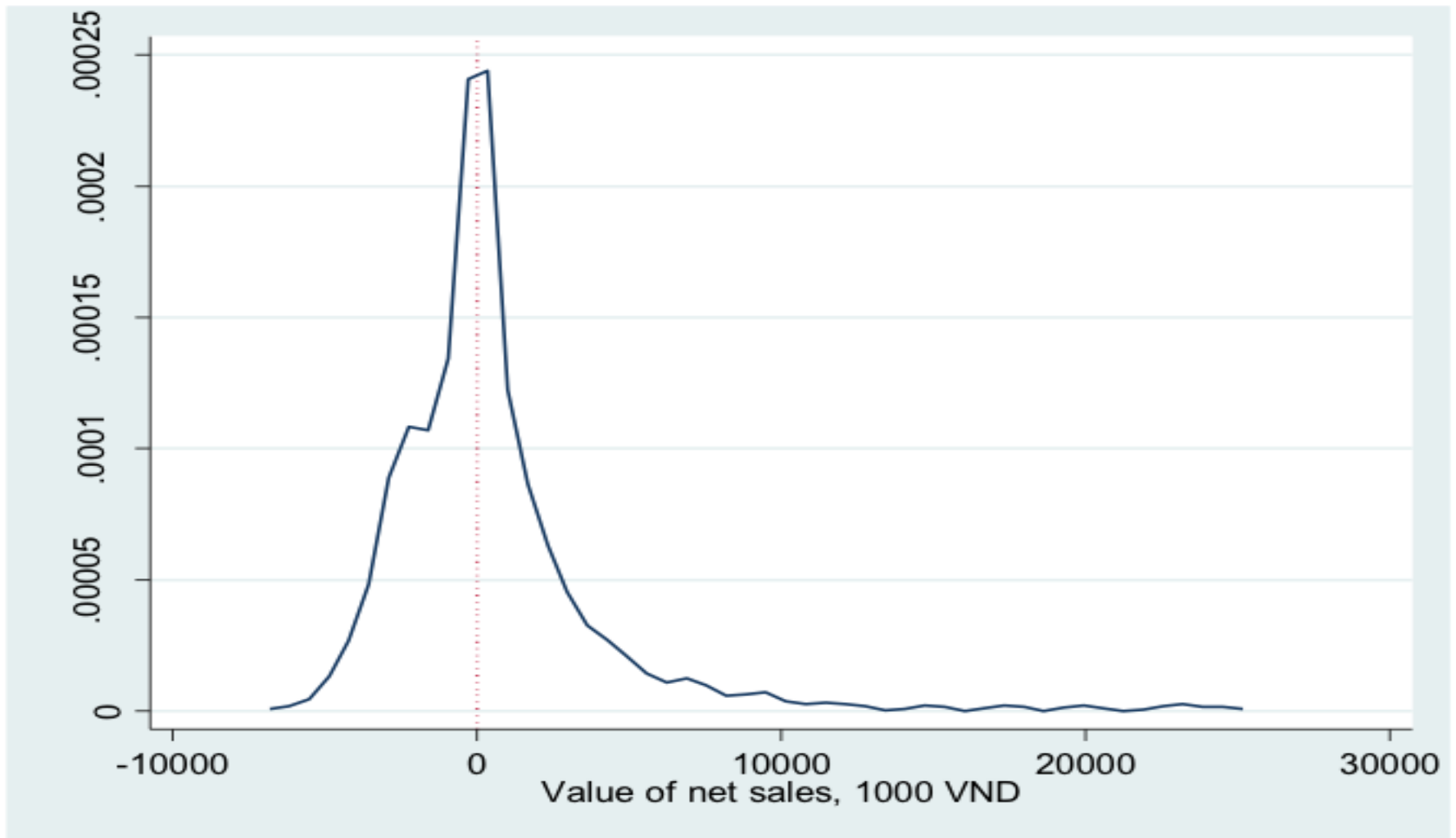
Vietnam: Urban households close to the poverty line, net sales of rice, 2006



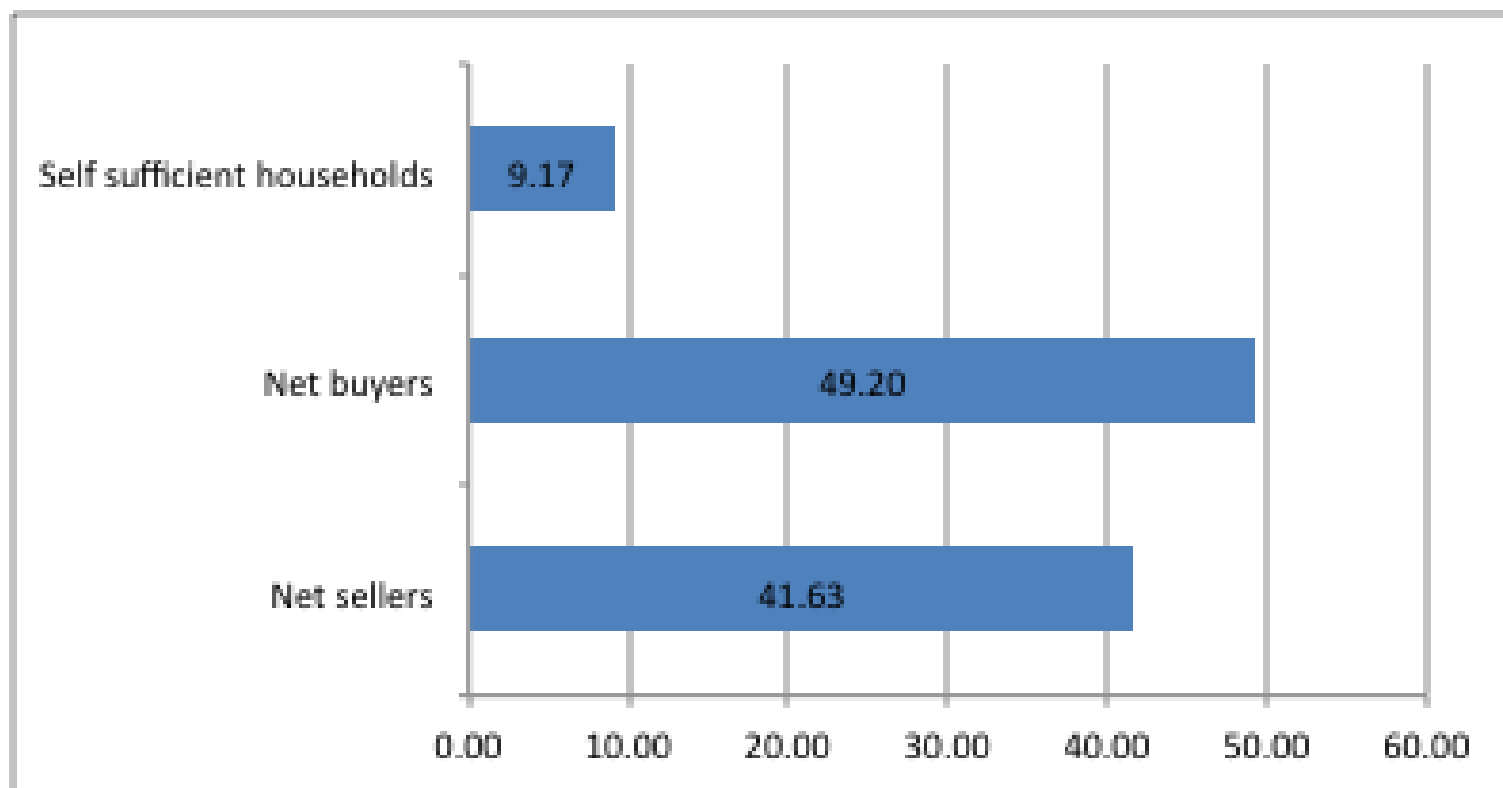

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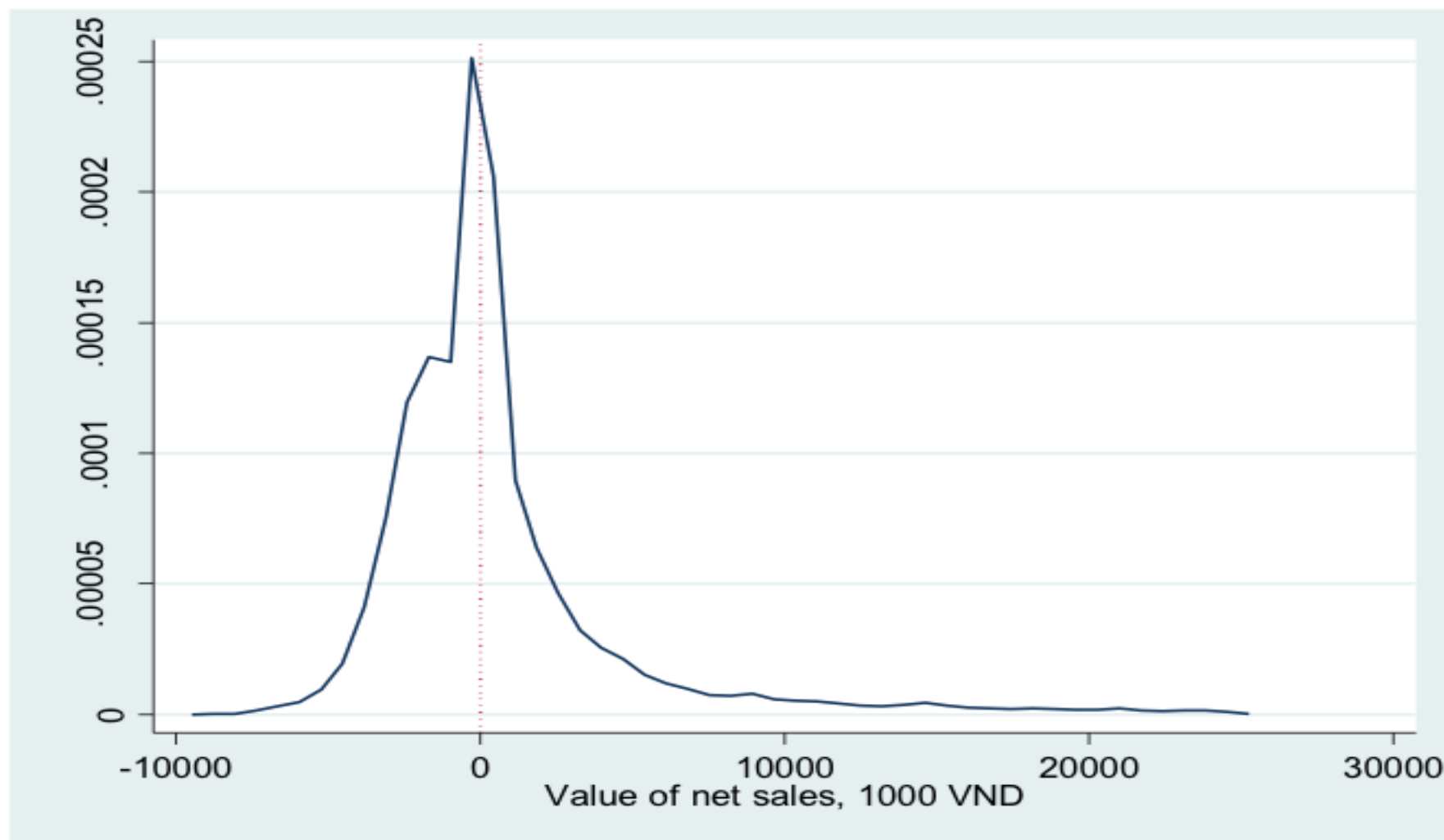

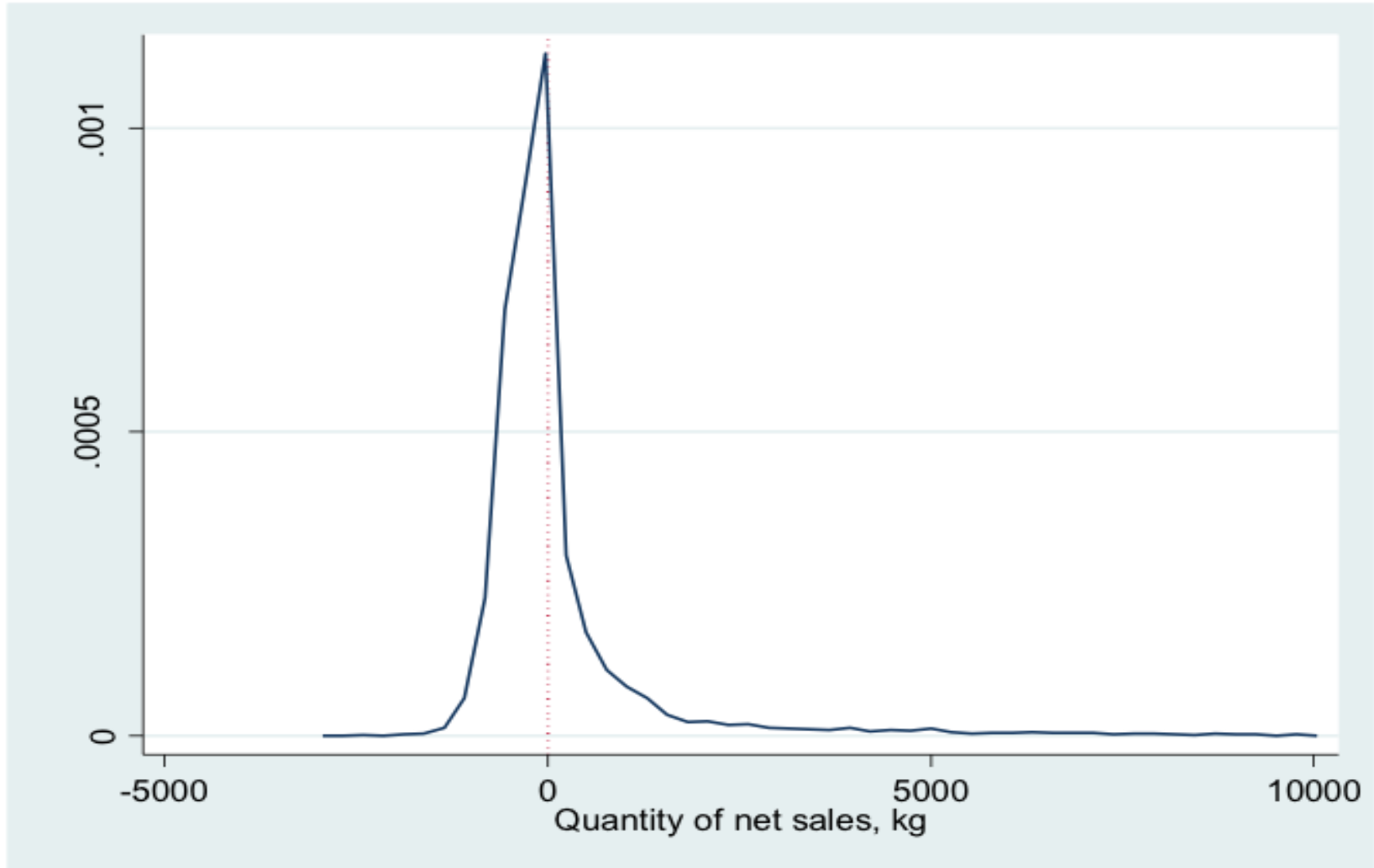
