



Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) 2022

What are the expectations for attending class in 2022?

Attendance at interactive classes is important for both on campus and online students. Real-time interaction, discussion and debate between students and with convenors is a central part of the learning experience.

Crawford School continues to allow you the flexibility to choose whether to study on campus or online. You will have access to the same level of interaction with your convenor and fellow students no matter which option you choose.

Many convenors will expect you to come to class (either online or on campus) with a firm expectation that you will have prepared for each seminar and be ready to actively engage discussions and forums. Assessment items are often completed in class time (presentations, participation, group work etc).

As at 12 January, on campus classes are going ahead for Semester 1 and ANU is open. If you wish to attend classes on campus in Canberra you should enrol in the in person/on campus class (using the *On Campus* class number on ISIS). We encourage students located in Canberra to attend their classes on campus, if possible. Please check [ANU COVID advice](#)

Some Summer courses will also have options to attend on campus.

What cohort am I in?

On ISIS you will have a choice of enrolling in an *online* or *on campus* class number for each course.

If you enrolled in the *On Campus* class you are the On Campus cohort and attend all activities listed for that cohort. Your seminars and tutorials will be face-to-face on campus.

If you are enrolled in the *Online* class you are in the Online cohort and attend all activities listed for that cohort. All classes will be online.

Can I enrol in the On Campus class for one course and the Online class for another?

Yes you can. As long as you stick with the same cohort for each course.

Where will my class be held?

Some of my courses don't have lectures listed but some do?

Some courses will have online live Lectures (indicated on the timetable) and some will have pre-recorded lecture material available on Wattle (not listed on the timetable).

What does 'online live' mean?

This means the lecture or seminar is conducted online at a specific time. You can watch/participate in the activity in real-time.

Will online live lectures be recorded?

Yes. Recordings are accessible via the Wattle course site.

How do I find out the times of my sessional courses (Summer/Autumn etc)?

Please refer to the ANU Timetable Viewer or the Wattle course site.

Are my class times listed on the ANU Timetable?

Can I change between modes – ie attend On Campus one week and Online the next?

No. You must stay in the cohort you are enrolled in. Monday of week 2 is the last day to change cohorts. If you are enrolled in the On Campus class you must stay in that class (and attend on campus classes) for the remainder of the semester. Likewise if you are enrolled in the Online class you must stay in that class for the duration of the Semester.

I can't attend one of my On Campus seminars. Can I attend the online seminar for that week?

Usually no, but please check with your course convenor.

Do I need to attend all Seminars?

Please note, attendance at seminars and tutorials is expected for all students and students who do not attend their classes may miss important information or assessment. However, if you are unwell please stay at home and do not attend classes on campus.

Will there be online class options available throughout 2022?

What are the COVID protocols for in-person teaching on campus?

Classrooms will be cleaned after each teaching session. Social distancing will be maintained in the classroom with rooms only filled to 50% capacity. Hand sanitizer is available throughout the campus. ANU will continue to align protocols with ACT Health.
